We have been looking at Roman art and making our own mosaics. We made coasters first and are now making a giant mosaic with a picture of a phoenix.

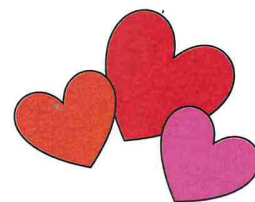
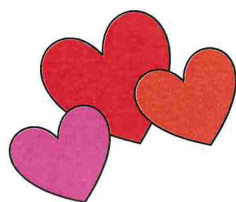


Tuck Shop
