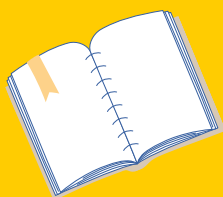

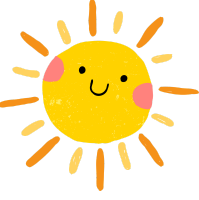

We are reading *The Hungry Caterpillar* and having fun looking at what foods he eats, and how he changes into a beautiful butterfly.

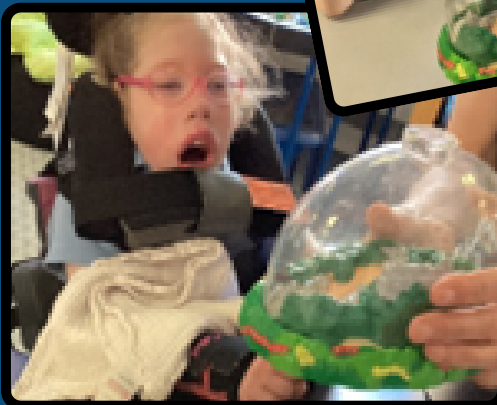
We have enjoyed lots of crafts including butterfly and caterpillar printing.
