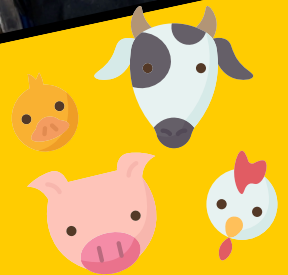


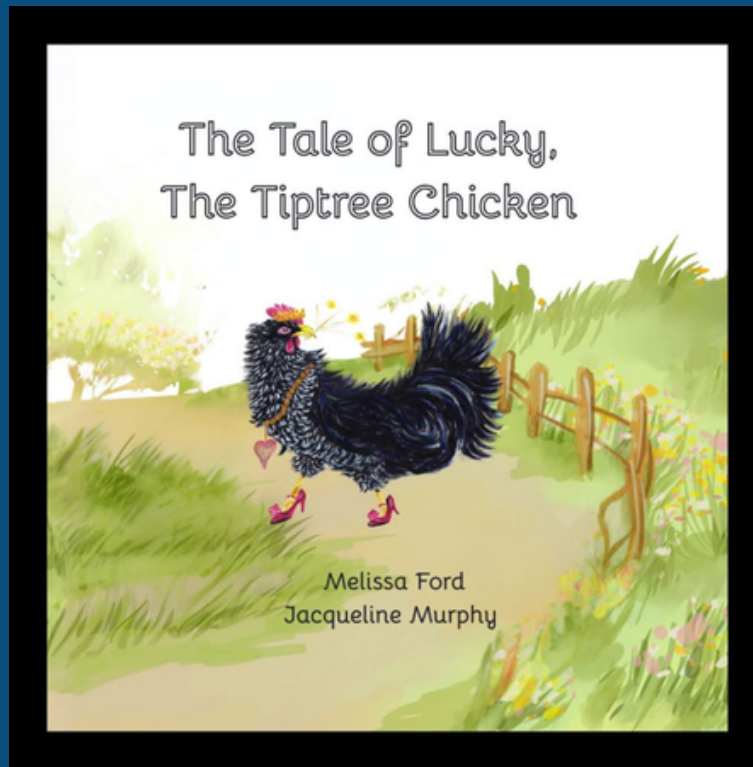
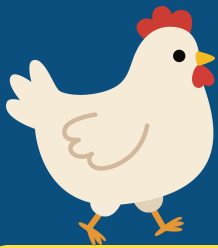
STARS CLASS NEWS

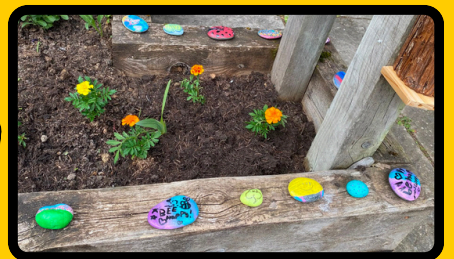
